- Household items
- Dishes, pots, pans
- Furniture, curtains
- Mattresses, box springs
- Metal
- Toys
- Reusable items
- Propane Tanks
- Electronics (anything with a cord except NO CRTs or big screen TVs)

Prohibited Items

- Construction Materials / Remodeling or Demolition Waste
- Landscape materials such as but not limited to concrete, asphalt, dirt, sod, brick, cement, sand, gravel, roofing materials, flooring, walls, siding, ceilings, insulation, electrical, asbestos or other fireproofing materials, etc.
- Most hazardous waste - SEE HAZARDOUS WASTE DETAILS ON PAGES BELOW
- Chemicals, gasoline, oil, paint, tar, animal waste, liquids or under the sink garbage
- Tires
- CRTs / Large old TVs
- CFL bulbs (not tubes nor broken)

Shredding Info

Onsite secure shredding via 'Shred Northwest' will be done for the first 3 hours of the Dumpster Day (9 AM to 12 Noon).

Shredding company will shred offsite* and provide a certificate of destruction to the PVNA (we will post on our city webpage the following week).

*This is an offsite purge, their driver will not shred any material at the location. The Driver will securely transport the material to Shred NW facility where it will be shredded under video surveillance and they will recycle the boxes for you.

Critical Safety Risks

Please make sure that the material and items you provide to Shred NW for shredding ONLY includes approved types of materials for the project. Paperclips, binder clips, hanging file folders, rubber bands and staples...all of the typical filing fasteners, DO NOT need to be removed. These are no problem for Shred NW shredders at all! However, **NO 3 ring binders, the paper needs to be removed and the binder disposed prior to shredding.** Their shredders are tough, but they are not designed to shred everything.

If there is a hard drive that is mixed in with paper, it could be very damaging and will likely start a fire! Please do not allow that to happen.

Be advised, **batteries, backup tapes, x-rays, live ammunition, prototypes, product/part samples, tools, garbage, and careless inclusion of unapproved items** will damage the shredders, contaminate recycling, and possibly cause fires. All of these items above are very real risks and have been sent into the shredders as concealed items, such unapproved materials are shown to have caused mechanical damage and fires. We want to avoid these situations!

If you have questions, please call Shred NW or ask PVNA for more info. Please sort out unapproved materials - if you aren't sure, let us know on the day of!

JOB DESCRIPTIONS FOR VOLUNTEERS

PLEASE PICK A SHIFT TO VOLUNTEER AND WHAT JOB YOU WOULD LIKE TO DO.

Join us in helping clean up the Pleasant Valley neighborhood Clean-up. We'll need volunteers from 8am to 4pm. The volunteer shifts are broken down to three time slots:

8:30am – 11:30am,
11:00am -2:00pm,
1:30pm – 3:30pm.

You are welcome to sign up for more than one shift. Lunch from a cart of your choice in the Chop Chop Food Pod will be provided.

JOB DESCRIPTIONS

- **BULKY WASTE COLLECTORS**- Empty Bulky waste out of vehicle into dumpsters. Be aware of items we **DO NOT ACCEPT**. (See flyer and keep it on hand).
- **GREETER/ TRAFFIC CONTROLLER/ runner** - Greet cars when they come in with a tally sheet. Assess load and collect money (Looking for materials we do not take). Write the donation amount in the yellow area of the tally sheet. Send the vehicle to the Traffic controller. Control traffic from the middle of the cleanup and ensure vehicles move along **SAFELY** and efficiently and so no one gets run over!
- **Free area RUNNER**- You will be at the bulky waste box waiting for items you think could be re-used and then take the items to the reuse area.
